THE TURKISH CHEMICAL SOCIETY

The Turkish Chemical Society(TCS) was founded in 1919.TCS is a non-profit scientific and professional organization which represents Turkish Chemists nationwide as well as internationally.

The General Council of the TSS, consisting of all members, meets once a year for the purpose of electing the offcers of the Executive Cmmittee, which is consists of 9 members a President, a Vice President, a General Secretary, an Accountant, a Treasurer and four members. TCS also has an Auditing Committee and a Discibline Committee. The Society has representatives in all Turkish Universities.

Membership is not compulsory. Any senior student of chemistry in an institution of higher education may become a "candidate member". This may turn into full membership as soon as he or she graduates. In addition hororary membership, membership of distinction and institutional membership are possible. Today, TCS has about 2000 members and 200 candidate members. The annuals membership fee, which is about 10 USD for full members, is the only source of the TCS.

T CS aims to be a source of information, both for chemists and for the public in general, about all issues concerning the science of chemistry and its applications. It cooperates with institutions of chemical education, communicates and protects the rights of chemists, suppors professionals advecement in all fields of chemistry, fosters cooperation between chemical professionals, organizers meetings, conferences, seminars, congresses and all kinds of scientific events, gives finantial

support to chemistry students and helps them find jobs or position for professional training.TCS publishes a "Monthly News Bulletin" and the journal "CHEMISTRY and INDUSTRY", which is published every three months, as well as various monographs.

In addition, TCS establishes and maintains relations with other similar institutions. It has been a National Adhering Organization of the International Union of Pure and Applied Chemistry (IUPAC) since 1958 and a members of the Federation of Buropean Chemical Societies (FECS) since 1985. It is also a member of the International Organization for the Chemical Sciences in Development (IOCD) and the Intarnational Organization of Balkan Chemistry Days (BCD).
