

Item 18: National Adhering Organization Status of Pakistan and Saudi Arabia

The letter that follows has been received from the NAO of Saudi Arabia. The Council is asked to accept to resignation of the NAO of Saudi Arabia.

The Pakistan Chemical Society was admitted as the National Adhering Organization of Pakistan at the Geneva Council meeting (1997). The PCS has not paid its National Subscription for 1998, 1999, or 2000. The PCS, when informed of the recommendation of the Finance Committee and the Executive Committee that NAO status be removed from the PCS, sent a message stating that they believed they would be able to pay at least part of their arrears before the Brisbane Council meeting. The Bureau will discuss the issue, based on the most current information at Brisbane and make a recommendation to Council.
